



## Hints and Tips About Parking at Glendon and TTC access

### Driving-Parking

Generally, we have found that the most desirable parking spots in Parking Lot A near the front entrance to York Hall fill up very quickly. **You need to arrive early to get a spot in the top parking lot.** If that parking lot is full, members can be directed to the lower-level parking lot. This parking lot is much larger; however, it does involve taking a staircase of about 115 steps to the upper level where York Hall is located. Access is located on the north side of York Hall where a branch road winds down the forested ravine into the lower lot.

If you prefer not to use the parking lots at Glendon you can **park along Lawrence Avenue, or elsewhere in the nearby neighborhood.** Please pull your car up so there is space for two cars between driveways, and please be respectful of the homeowners' access.

Another suggestion is to **car-pool** with fellow members when coming to Glendon. This has worked well for many over the years.

### TTC Access

**The TTC has stops on Lawrence Avenue East, near the Bayview Ave entrance gates to Glendon, which are on the east side of Bayview Ave.** These stops are on the east and west sides of the Lawrence Ave. bridge which crosses over Bayview Ave.

(Note that Lawrence Avenue East is not a continuous city traffic artery. It stops at Bayview Ave. (at Glendon) and does not cross the Don Valley ravine. It resumes just west of Leslie St. to continue easterly towards and through Don Mills, Scarborough, etc. Local residential streets can be used to wind around this break. Thus, there is no bus service along Lawrence between Bayview and Leslie).

Most TTC bus routes start and end at Subway stations; those that are most direct with no route transfers start from either the Davisville station or the Lawrence Station.

- Coming from Davisville Station, or from Bayview Ave. south of Lawrence, northbound Routes 11, 11A or 11B will take you north to Lawrence; however, there is a short detour through Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre on the way up to Lawrence.
- Northbound Bayview Route 11C does **not go** to Lawrence Ave. (See TTC note below.)
- Coming from Bayview Ave north of Lawrence, southbound Route 11 or 11A will take you south to Lawrence.
- You can also take either Route 124 (see TTC note below) or 162 bus from the Lawrence subway station, which proceeds eastbound on Lawrence Ave to the Lawrence Ave. bridge location at Bayview for Glendon access.

### TTC Note:

Due to construction at the Lawrence Ave Subway station during the Fall of 2024, the following temporary route changes have been made:

- Route 124 has been suspended and does not operate.
- In its place there are 2 choices:
  - Route 11C now operates in extended mode, and continues northward along Bayview from Sunnybrook to Lawrence Ave., and thence to Lawrence Subway Station, continuing via a circuitous route back to Bayview and eventually up to Steeles Avenue. It then retraces this route back to Davisville station. (This is not an attractive or efficient option coming from the north above Lawrence Ave.)
  - Route 52G (labelled Lawrence West) will continue eastward along Lawrence from the subway station, and thence southbound on Bayview to Sunnybrook, temporarily replacing the former 124 route.
